word on the gators:

- **return trip:** The Gators are making their second appearance at the Land of Magic Classic in four seasons. In 2006-07, the Blue and Gold dropped decisions to Lawrence (69-57) and Mary Washington (68-61). Among the seniors, who at that time were freshmen, George Raftis was the only one to see game time in Florida. In two contests, he went 7 of 12 from the field (.583) and 3 of 5 from the free-throw line (.600) while compiling 17 points, eight rebounds and two steals.

- **last time out:** Blair Rozenblad scored 21 points, including the go-ahead layup with 13 seconds remaining, to lift Thiel over the Allegheny, 84-82, in non-conference play on Dec. 9. Donte Briscoe, who was 8 of 12, finished with 16 points, five rebounds, three steals and two assists for the Gators. George Raftis also scored 16 points, shooting 8 of 10 from the field. Craig Devinney and James Ness finished with 13-point totals while Charlie Jaicks added 10 points and five rebounds.

- **milestone watch:** Seniors George Raftis and Craig Devinney will have the opportunity to move up the all-time career rankings in a number statistical categories. Raftis has risen to 19th place all-time with 1,046 points as a Gator. He trails Dave Contardi (1977-81) and Casey McCloskey (2003-07), who share 17th with 1,056 points. Raftis is also seventh with 597 rebounds – 20 behind Ben Schulz (617 in 1994-98) and 30 behind Brian Stadnik (627 in 1982-87). Devinney, who is ranked 10th all-time with 115 three-pointers, trails Matt Magnusen by one (116 in 2000-04), Nick Catanzarite by seven (122 in 1999-03), Jake Delsandro by eight (1996-00) and Rich Seidel by 11 (126 in 1985-88).

word on the knights:

• **leading the way:** Prior to the Land of Magic Classic, Kelly McCarville has averaged a team-leading 20.8 points per game for Wartburg. McCarville also leads the team in field goal percentage (.657) and steals (17) and ranks second in rebounds per game (6.0) and assists (21).

• **fearsome foursome:** Including Kelly McCarville (20.8 ppg), four different Knights are averaging double-figures in scoring. The others are Mitch Eslick (13.4), Cole Danielson (12.4) and Jordan Sathoff (12.3).

• **supporting cast:** Jordan Sathoff leads Wartburg in rebounds per game (8.3) and blocks (12) while Cole Danielson tops the squad in three-point field-goal percentage (.476) and Mitchell Murphy has the most assists (40).

• **the hawkeye state:** Wartburg, which has won 21 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IAC) Championships, is coached by two-time IAC Coach of the Year Dick Peth. As a program, the Knights have reached the D-III Elite 8 (1986-87) and Sweet 16 (1990-91). They will also become Allegheny's first-ever opponent out of the IAC.

• **out of the gate:** The Knights are off to their best start at 5-3 since they began the 2005-06 season with an 8-1 record, which eventually ballooned to 17-3. In 2009-10, Wartburg has won three of its first four games away from home.

word on the pioneers:

• **now starring:** John Hoch has led Carroll thus far during the 2009-10 campaign, topping team statistical categories such as points per game (26.0), assists (36), field-goal percentage (.489) and free-throw percentage (.911).

• **also featured:** Paul Grosshuesch leads the Pioneers in steals (7) and ties for the team lead in rebounds per game (7.3) along with Taylor Patrick. Grosshuesch is also second on the team in scoring (10.3 points per game) while Eric Williams is third (10.1).

• **monsters of the midwest:** Members of the Midwest Conference, the Pioneers (4-3, 1-1 MWC) have made two recent NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2006-07. Allegheny's matchup with Carroll will be only its second contest against a team from the MWC – the previous being a 69-57 loss to Lawrence at the 2006 Land of Magic Classic.
